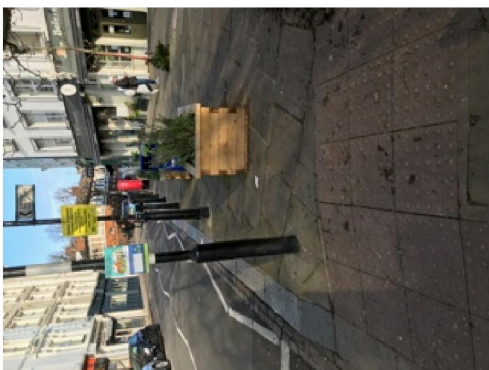
I just wanted to add a further comment on the planter arrangements for the above application.

The current layout does not follow the Councils efforts to provide suitable walkways for the reduction in transmission of Covid 19 and normal usage, The planters along Belsize Lane are far to close to the road and blocked by bollards which makes walking, wheelchair, or push chair use impossible, the net result of which forces pedestrians to walk through the tables and chairs when they are on the triangle passing through the seated diners unless they cross via the Zebra and pass through queues outside the greengrocer and the grocers shop.

I would add again the planters are welcome but not in the current layout this needs to be reviewed and made Covid 19 compliant.
