- G1 Row of 36 Conifers Poor condition- outgrown hedge row. Fell to ground level T2 Sycamore Crown reduce by approx 3-4m and balance sides to create a tight crown -
- T3 Cherry Twin Stem Reduce height by approx 3m, crown thin by 20% and balance rest of tree
- T4 Dead Conifer Fell
- T6 x2 Conifer sp. Reduce in height by approx 2-3m retaining enough live growth. Do not trim sides
- T7 Hornbeam Remove two lowest branches towards the house to raise crown.
- T8 Robinia sp. Reduce lateral branches away from house by 1-2m and dead wood
