I am writing on behalf of The Society of Analytical Psychology which is situated directly opposite the proposed development. I have to object most strongly to this development.

The Society offers psychotherapeutic help to patients with psychological difficulties. We already are upset by the difficulties of noise in the busy environment which surrounds the clinic. We can only foresee that the excavation and destruction of our pleasant environment will cause further distress to ourselves and our patients. The function of Belsize Lane and Daleham Gardens is busy and often hazardous. The IGA, The Tavistock Clinic and our Society have endeavoured to lend some dignity to the neighbourhood by our concerned care for our premises and gardens.

I cannot imagine that the constructing of a three storey residential building comprising 5 flats can add anything other than distress for our neighbourhood and even more overcrowding and difficulty. I can only feel that 20 underground parking spaces will make further mayhem and noise while destroying the pleasant outlook we have at present. It also seems an excessive requirement for when I have written in the past about our difficulties in parking we have had no reply.

I cannot be more outspoken about our distress at your proposed project and urge you to decry such a scheme.
