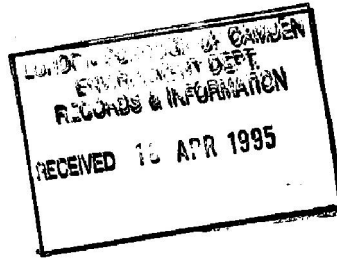

Re: **Planning Application PL/9500249/ /0711/K**
Construction of 5 flats and underground car park
adjoining 79 Belsize Lane, NW3

The construction of a 3-storey residential building with such substantial car parking appears out of keeping in a carefully planned leafy Victorian neighbourhood. The proposed development appears crowded in relation to the site, and appears likely to introduce additional traffic hazards, and to complicate the traffic flow at an already dangerous junction.

This Institute is situated directly opposite the proposed site, and as an organisation providing psychotherapy and training we are very concerned about the impact of the excavation that would be needed to construct the proposed building. I would therefore like to endorse the points made in [REDACTED] letter of 3rd April 1995 and to express the strongest possible objection to the proposed development.
