Re: Application Reference No. PL/9500249/ /0711/K
Construction of a 3-storey residential building
comprising 5 flats and 20 underground parking
spaces on land adjoining 79 Belsize Lane, NW3.

On behalf of the Institute of Group Analysis situated
directly opposite to the proposed development, I write
to strongly object to this application.

In the first place, 20 parking places for five flats seems
rather excessive and in all probability will be used for
hotel parking resulting in cars coming and going on the
existing hazardous junction of Belsize Lane and Daleham Gardens.
Excavation for the car park is also bound to affect if not
destroy trees which add so much to the charm of our neighbourhood.

Secondly, in view of the nature of the psychotherapy carried
out on our own premises, the noise and disturbance of such
excavation will be particularly stressful and detrimental to
our work. We anticipate a distressing and adverse affect on
our clients and will find it difficult to cope with it.

We deplore this proposal and entreat you to reject it.
