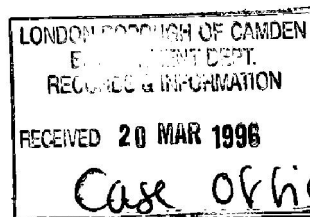
Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to you to formally object most strongly to the proposed extension to the rear of 42-45 Belsize Park.

I am the resident of the garden flat of 41 Belsize Park and the rear elevation of 42 Belsize Park already extends 4.5 metres further out than our rear elevation. As we are a North West facing flat this prevents sunlight from reaching our flat for much of the year. On examining the plans of the proposed development I observed that the building will extend a further 4.5-5 metres out from the existing rear elevation, effectively doubling the amount of shadow that I receive from that building. As I am already in the shadow of this building for much of the day, I would be most distressed to lose any of the little amount of sunlight which does manage to shine into my flat in the late afternoons of the mid-summer months. I also feel that the amount of general light and air that reaches me will be severely cut down by this extension. I therefore appeal to you to refuse this application forthwith.

I would be most grateful if you could inform me of the date of the committee.
