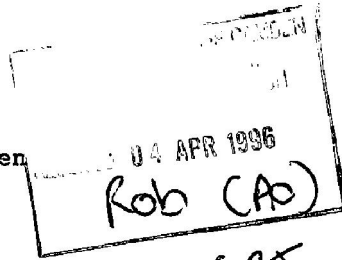

Re: 42-45 Belsize Park and road adjacent to 79 Belsize Lane, NW3.  
Application No. 9500249R3. Case File G7/11/K.

Further to the letter, dated 21/3/96, from [REDACTED],  
Chairman of The Institute of Group Analysis, objecting to this  
proposal, I wish to add two points raised by our House  
Management Committee.

We are dismayed about the intended extension of the building  
beyond the present rear building line. This would take away  
valuable garden space in a conservation area. Although our  
Institute is strapped for cost, we allocate a budget for our  
garden so as to make it attractive to our students, teachers,  
patients, as well as to passers-by. We do not wish to see this  
area spoilt by the building opposite our own.

The other point concerns the provision of 17 car parking spaces  
for 26 residential units. There will obviously be a need for  
some residents to leave their cars outside the new premises in  
residents' parking bays. When the proposed extension of the  
Belsize PCZ becomes operative there will be grossly inadequate  
pay-and-display provision for the users of this Institute,  
and we will certainly have to press for further pay-and-display  
bays, reducing the number of bays now reserved for residents.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. I trust you will  
give due attention to our areas of concern.
