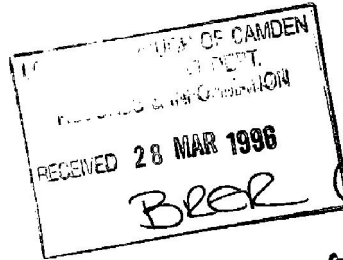

Thank you for your letter concerning the application for change of use and the development of a three-storey rear extension and car parking spaces.

I would like to enter a strenuous objection to the development proposed. The site concerned is already heavily developed, and lies within a pleasant Victorian conservation area. The proposed three-storey rear extension would constitute over-developmet of the site, and would create a massive, dominating outlook. As many as 17 car parking spaces would add significant congestion to an area which already suffers from excessive traffic. The junction nearby is busy and the significant increase in traffic near the junction is highly undesirable.
