The change of use of the existing buildings from a hostel to 26 self contained resedential units together with the erection of a three storey rear extension, and the landscaping of the land to the rear together with the provision of 17 surface car parking spaces. (REVISED PLANS SUBMITTED) .

Comments of the central entrance in the link block, which despite the reestablishment of the original entrances to the hall floors of the four houses, gives the impression of a block of flats. This central entrance should be made less conspicuous.


We object to the stepped out effect that has been produced by the extension at the rear, the bay windows being made to project from an extension which itself projects.

We also would prefer to see the rear dormers made narrower so that

the edge nearest to the party wall aligns with the window below.

We note that KKM Architects say that they are "not pursuing the new buildings at the rear and this shall be covered in a later letter." Does this mean that they intend later to build at the rear as well as having now applied for the rear extensions?

The rear of these buildings is very prominent and visible from Belsize Lane and needs careful design and landscaping,
