REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Ash (T1) - Fell to ground level and grind out stump.

The Council has considered your application dated 23 November 2020 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The application is for the removal of an ash tree from the front garden of a residential property that is situated within the Highgate Village Conservation Area.

The large, mature ash tree is highly visible from the public and significantly contributes to the character and appearance of the conservation area. The tree is landscape feature in the streetscene and provide a high level of public amenity. The tree is visible from in excess of 100m away from the tree to the east and west along Hampstead Lane.

The tree is approx. 15m in height and appears to be in at least fair condition both structurally and physiologically. The tree has been crown reduced historically.

The application alleges the tree is damaging a boundary wall that will require reconstruction. The boundary wall is subordinate to the tree and is likely there is a design and/or engineering solution that will allow for the wall to be reconstructed and the tree to be retained.

Objections from Highgate CAAC, The Highgate Society and the Highgate Neighbourhood Forum demonstrate there is significant local interest in the tree and public support for its retention.

The application be refused to protect the amenity the tree provides and the character and appearance of the conservation area.
