

- (1) New mahogany screen, dimensions as shown.
- (2) Numbered subjects are historic stained glass panels (currently in the Museum's collection, that will be incorporated into this new screen). Their arrangment will reinstate the 1837 arrangment.
- (3) Missing panels from the collection will be glazed in an antique semi transparent glass.
- (4) Glazing bars will be moulded to match the detail as shown on the detail of the Cupboard 100 door, see drawing 506SR/DD002. NB Due to the slenderness of the glazing bars and the addition of safety glass, an concealed internal stainless steel frame will be incorporated into the frame. This frame will be painted in on the west face and hidden by timber mouldinfs on the east face.
- (5) Grey lines indicate proposed lead cames.
- (6) Amber areas indicate areas of amber coloured glass (to match sample of Soane's original coloured glass on site).
- (7) Yellow areas indicate areas of yellow coloured glass (to match sample of Soane's original coloured glass on site).
- (8) Pale yellow areas indicate areas of pale yellow coloured glass (to match sample of Soane's original coloured glass on site).
- (9) Glazing will be protected with a layer of safety glass in front of the historic glazing.
- (10) Panel at low level will be constructed in solid mahogany with flush triple bead moulding (each bead 5mm dia).




GROUND FLOOR PLAN

- (4) Create new lining to the side of the stairs, reusing the existing timber linings.

GROUND FLOOR PLAN



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
General Notes:

- The proposed works to the Ground Floor to reinstate Soane's 1837 arrangement for the upper area of the Basement Stairs and include the modifications to the top three steps may have an minor impact on the lobby 13RmB/27 to the west of the Basement East Corridor.

- NB: All the works noted on this drawing will only be carried out if absolutely necessary. If the works to the upper level of the basement stairs can be carried without removing the boxing out, it will be retained in-situ as existing.

- 1 Dismantle the existing sloping boxed-in soffit on the north west corner of lobby 13RmB/27, ceiling boards to be set aside for re-use.
- (2) Carry out works to the timber strings of the basement stairs and install new s/w timber bearers to create a new down-stand sloping boxed-in soffit to accommodate the position of the stairs in their original position.
- (3) Reinstate linings to the sloped boxed-in soffit, reusing the existing boarding.
- (4) Carry out minor works to the plaster bead cornice, as necessary.






GROUND FLOOR PLAN AS EXISTING
