The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed amendment to the scheme to include the retention of part of a 3 storey building abutting 42 Phoenix Road and Clarendon Grove, by reason of its

size, bulk, materials and design, is incongruous to the streetscape, harms the appearance of the school and the street frontage, obscures public views to and from Clarendon Grove, reduces passive surveillance from the site and has the potential to increase the fear of crime contrary to Policy D1 (Design) and Policy C5 (Safety and security) of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

In absence of a deed of variation to the S106 Legal Agreement secured as part of planning permission ref: 2016/3476/P approved on the 01/12/2016 the development would fail to ensure the development complies with the ongoing heads of terms including car free, school development travel plan, employment and training plan, local procurement, sustainability plan contrary to planning policies G1 (Delivery and Location of Growth), E1 (Economic Development), CC1 (Climate change mitigation), CC2 (Adapting to Climate Change), CC4 (Air quality), T1 (Prioritising walking, cycling and public transport), T2 (parking and car free development), and DM1 (Delivering and Monitoring) of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
