The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** listed building consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed external and internal condenser units and associated louvres, by virtue of their size, design, location and visibility would result in harm to the special architectural and historic interest of the Grade II Listed Building, the character and appearance of the street scene and wider Hampstead Conservation Area. Whilst the harm is considered to be less than substantial, there are no demonstrable public benefits to outweigh the harm caused. The proposal is therefore contrary to Policy D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan 2017 and Policy DH2 of the Hampstead Neighbourhood Plan 2018.
