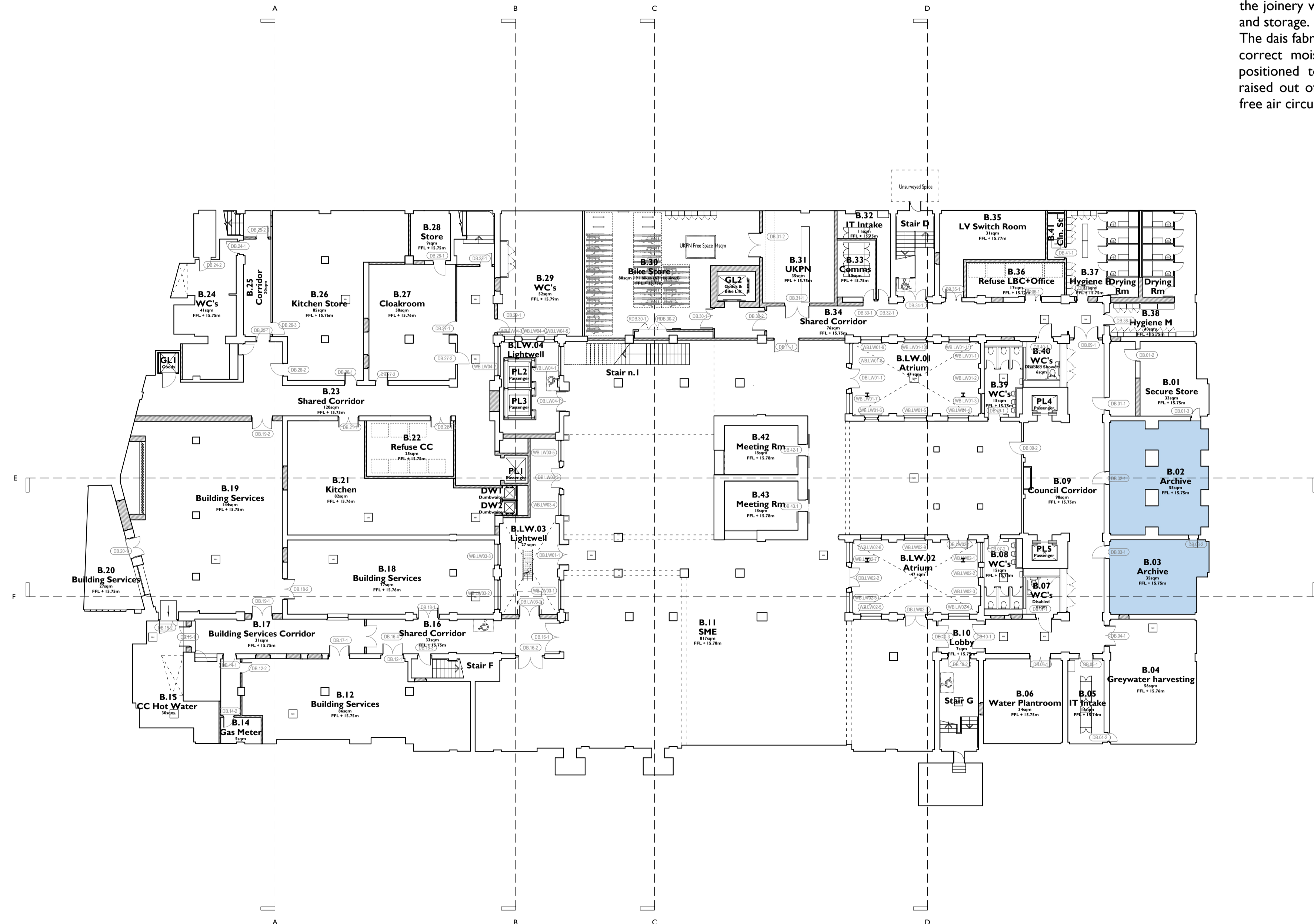
The fabric removed from the dais within the Council Chamber shall be stored on site. Details of the storage shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the LPA prior to the fabric being removed.

 Store rooms designated for the storage of fabric removed from the dais within the Council Chamber

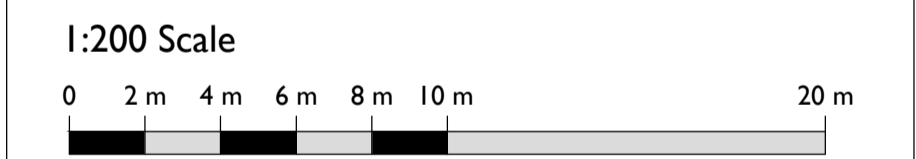
For the fabric removal itself, various hand tools will be used to remove panels without damaging the existing joinery, each section will be catalogued and labelled to where the item came from and a unique reference given to that item, once removed the joinery will be protected and labelled up ready for removal and storage.

The dais fabric will be kept in a heated dry store to maintain the correct moisture content. They will be stacked on bearers positioned to provide adequate support. The fabric will be raised out of contact with the ground and covered - allowing free air circulation.


