This is an already very built up area with limited parking for residents, tradespeople, deliveries and, especially, emergency services. There are three major secondary schools within close proximity whereby many pupils walk past here. This will result in even more congestion as regards traffic and the possible hazards to their safety. Then there is our own dwelling and that of our neighbours. The sense of distance and light from the bedrooms adjacent to Gordon House will be severely restricted and the potential noise disturbance from an even higher density of people cannot be avoided.</p>
