In the back of our gardens we have tributaries of the river Fleet running through them. Any basement would have to have a continuous running pump to ensure there would be no internal flooding. This would create noise for the neighbours. Also a basement would be a subsidence risk to houses nearby and create a change in the gound conditions permanently. 500m2 of soil would have to be removed which will cause nuisance to any neighbours around the house. Holy Lodge Estate is a conservation area and the lightwells would look out of place in this area. A full basement with a side stair could create a separate dwelling which is against the covenants which permit only one house per site. once granted this development could lead to many more which would be detrimental yo all the residents
