Assessment

The s.211 notification is for the removal of an ash tree and a cherry tree from the rear garden of a residential property that is situated within the Hampstead Conservation Area.

The ash tree is is poor structural condition with advanced basal decay. Approx 60-70% of base of tree absent. There is evidence of the fungal organism *Kretzschmaria deusta* at the base of tree which is likely to be the cause of the decay. There is no known cure or treatment for this fungi. The tree is not considered to be suitable for a tree preservation order based on its condition alone.

The cherry tree is dead.

It is not expedient for the Council to serve a tree preservation order to protect the trees.

The Council does not object to the proposed works.
