Front Garden:

T1 & T2: 2 x Large Horse Chestnut: Located on the front boundary. Reduce crowns by 25-30% (2.50-3.00m). Thin crown densities by 20%. Raise crowns over pavement by 2.00m. Remove dead wood.

Reasons: General maintenance to help reduce hazard potential, increase light levels and help manage the trees at reasonable dimensions for their locations.

T3: Magnolia: Located on the front boundary. Reduce crown by 1.00m and thin crown density by 20%.

Reason: General maintenance.

T4: Ailanthus: Reduce crown by approximately 3.50-4.00m.

Reasons: The tree is growing within close proximity of the building. It has poor structure and has become large for its location.
