## SUBMISSION OF DETAILS PURSUANT TO THE PARTIAL DISCHARGE OF CONDITION 4 BRICK SAMPLES OF PLANNING PERMISSION 2020/1547/P

## ARTHUR STANLEY HOUSE, 40-50 TOTTENHAM STREET, LONDON, W1T 4RN.

On behalf of our client, 1921 Mortimer Investments Limited (the "Applicant"), please find enclosed the following documents which are being submitted to partially discharge Condition 4 of the abovementioned planning permission, in relation to the details and samples of the glazed brick fronting the residential entrance.

- Application Forms, prepared by DP9;
- Planning Condition 4 Report Glazed Bricks, prepared by AHMM.

## Condition 4 (brick samples) is outlined below:

- a) A sample panel of the facing brickwork (1.5 x 1.5 metres) demonstrating the proposed colour, texture, face-bond and pointing shall be provided on site and approved in writing by the local planning authority for the glazed bricks at ground floor level and the 'hit and miss' bricks for the rooftop plant, before the relevant parts of the works are commenced and the development shall be carried out in accordance with the approval given.
- b) The proposals shall be built in accordance with the details for facing bricks approved under planning reference 2020/2891/P dated 26 November 2020.

The approved panel shall be retained on site until the work has been completed.

This submission relates solely to the glazed brick reffered to in part a) of Condition 4. The enclosed document prepared by AHMM displays the samples of the glazed brick, demonstrating the proposed colour, texture, face-bond and pointing. This brick is utilised to create a feature to the entrance of the residential building as indicated in the AHMM document and as previously discussed with LBC during the determination period of the previous facing brick submission (ref. 2020/2891/P) made under Condition 4, and referenced in part b).



Following the submission of the glazed brick, the 'hit and miss' brick sample is the remaining item requiring submission under Condition 4 (part a). This submission will follow in due course.
