I write to object to Essential Livings' latest effort to reduce even further its initial s106 legal commitment to gift Camden some £11.5M to avoid having to follow Camden's guidelines to build 50% affordable units in its 184 unit skyscraper at 100 Avenue Road.

It will not come as a surprise to anyone that local residents – who fought tirelessly against this loathsome build for over 6 years - care not a jot that EL's potential profits from the build have by now dwindled to a mere £15M! and that they would - alas - have to abandon this development altogether for want of viability [i.e. enough profit] if Camden does not allow them this latest attempt to pull back on their promises.
