Dear Nathaniel

We have lived at 69 Arlington Road for 30 years and it has just been brought to our attention that a planning application has been made for 71 Arlington Road.

We would not normally object to an improvement to a neighbouring property but are very concerned that the extreme length and height of the proposed extension – which is out of character with this historic listed terrace - will significantly decrease the light and openness of our garden and that of the neighbouring gardens. We are also concerned about the light pollution and noise from the proposed skylights. The gardens at the back of this terrace are a haven for wildlife including songbirds and bats. The bats, in particular, are likely to be detrimentally affected by the light pollution.
