DISCHARGE OF PLANNING CONDITION – 2017/5071/P ORT HOUSE CONFERENCE CENTRE, 126 ALBERT STREET, NW1 7NE

On behalf of our client, the World ORT Trust, please find enclosed an application for the approval of details reserved by condition 5 pursuant to planning permission 2017/5071/P dated 25 July 2018.

Condition 5 relates to the submission of details demonstrating how trees to be retained shall be protected during construction works, prior to the commencement of development:

The condition states:

"Prior to the commencement of any works on site, details demonstrating how trees to be retained shall be protected during construction work shall be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority in writing. Such details shall follow guidelines and standards set out in BS5837:2012 "Trees in relation to design, demolition and construction". All trees on the site, or parts of trees growing from adjoining sites, unless shown on the permitted drawings as being removed, shall be retained and protected from damage in accordance with the approved protection details.

Reason: To ensure that the development will not have an adverse effect on existing trees and in order to maintain the character and amenity of the area in accordance with the requirements of policies A2 and A3 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017".

The following documents are submitted in respect of condition 5:

- Arboricultural Assessment and Method Statement, Barrell Tree Consultancy; and
- Email from Chris Allder, Barrell Tree Consultancy, dated 19 February 2021.

An Arboricultural Assessment and Method Statement was submitted and approved with the original planning application (July 2017).

This includes the Tree Protection Plan, comprising identification of the existing trees, their categories, root protection areas, trees to be removed and the location of the construction exclusion zone.

Barrell Tree Consultancy have assessed the plans submitted as part of the NMA application (reference 2020/1359/P) and noted that there have been no changes on site since the completion of the Arboricultural Assessment and Method Statement report.

The enclosed email from Chris Allder at Barrell Tree Consultancy confirms that the approved plans, and works to commence the development, do not change the original recommendations in the Arboricultural reports. The Tree Protection Plan and Report are therefore relevant and should be followed during construction.

On this basis it is considered that sufficient information has been submitted to satisfy the requirements of condition 5.
