1 Reasons for approval-

The proposed bird boxes would be located at least 2 metres above finished floor level within the eleventh floor plant enclosure, and would generally be east facing and out of direct sunlight. The proposed bat boxes would also be located on the roof and would be at least 3.5m above finished floor level. The submitted details are therefore in general accordance with the Camden

Biodiversity Action Plan and considered to secure the appropriate features to conserve wildlife habitats and biodiversity measures within the development.

Given the above, the submitted details are considered sufficient to discharge condition 3.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the host building and surrounding area.
