				I am writing to express my concern about the proposal to convert Boston House in Fitzroy Square into a University for up to 1200 students. If this Planning Application were to be accepted it would change forever the character of Fitzroy Square. The Square currently has a mix of residential and office space, which leads to a harmonious environment. A University with 1200 students will increase the level of noise in the Square and is likely to increase littering; the number of bicycles that the students would bring cannot be parked in a sensible manner in the square.
				As a resident of Fitzroy Square, I feel that my concerns with regards to this project are not being listened to. I objected to the previous Planning Application from NCH due to concerns that this would have on the character of the Square; this revised application makes no changes to take account of the concerns of residents, but rather increases the capacity of the University.
