1 Reason for granting permission-

Condition 5 requires detail drawings, samples of materials and manufacturers specifications of the obscure glazed screen to be submitted.

In respect of the frame the detailed drawings demonstrate that it would be

slimline in terms of thickness (40mm post and 10mm horizontal dividing steel members) and would ensure that the screen is lightweight in appearance. The details submitted demonstrate that the high quality that was secured within the original application will be carried forward to the detailed design stage. The applicant has confirmed that the screen would be constructed using steel and the glazing would be obscured toughened glass. This would be considered appropriate on the rear of this residential building.

The submitted details are consistent with the general expectations of the approved scheme and are acceptable in all other respects.

As such the proposals are in general accordance with policies D1 and D2 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
