## REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

Address: 10 Bartholomew Road London NW5 2AJ

Proposal:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Lime (Tilia spp) (T1) - Reduce branches overhanging 6 Lawford Road back to previous reduction points approx.4 - 5m.

The Council has considered your application dated 11 January 2021 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The application is for pruning works to a lime tree that is subject to a TPO. The tree is in the rear garden of residential property that is situated within the Bartholomew Estate Conservation Area.

The application is for a crown reduction of one side of a mature lime tree. The reduction would remove up to 5m of material and has been submitted on behalf of an owner/occupier of a neighbouring property, it is overhanging material that is proposed for removal.

The proposed works are considered to be harmful to the amenity the tree provides as only one side of the tree is proposed to be prune which will leave it looking unbalanced aesthetically and is likely to affect wind loading.

The justification for the works is that the tree is blocking light. This is not considered robust enough justification to adversely affect the amenity the tree provides by pruning one side of it.

The agent was informed that were the application to be amended to a crown reduction of the entire crown to previous points it would be likely to be approved. The council did not receive an instruction to amend the application.

The application has been refused to protect the amenity the tree provides and the character and appearance of the conservation area.
