(Please Note: The % relates just to the tree canopy and not the entire tree height). Remove all major dead and diseased wood and generally clean up canopy. Species: 1 x llex (Holly) Position: Front boundary Reason: Trespass over pavement & into adjacent Betula Remove lower branches to a vertical height of 4m, above ground level or raised surface, removing entire branches, or part of same that extend below the specific clearance height, with final cuts made to the branch collar or nearest growing point, B.S.3998:13.5. Top out by approximately 4m, in height, to reduce vertical growth, leaving canopy shaped to B.S.3998. Species: 1 x Acer (Sycamore)

Position: Neighbour's rear garden- Number 6 Willow Road Reason: Cyclical / Outgrowing location

Reduce and shape crown(s) by approximately 30%, removing lateral growth by approximately 3m, cutting back to nearest suitable growing point, to leave a flowing branch line without stumps and the main canopy framework to B.S.3998:13.4.1. (Please Note: The % relates just to the tree canopy and not the entire tree height).

Remove all major dead and diseased wood and generally clean up canopy
