Trees are of great importance to the character of the Redington Frogнал Conservation Area, as noted by AECOM in its study of Contribution of Trees to Townscape Character

and in the Redington & Frogнал Conservation Area Character and Management Plan under section 3.4 Townscape and Landscape Character and section 3.6 Harm; eg:

“Trees are a key part of the garden suburb character, so tree losses are particularly harmful.”

No reason has been provided for wishing to fell the two rear hornbeams and the front garden cherry. In the absence of a valid reason, the Neighbourhood Forum therefore requests TPO for all of these trees, on the grounds of contribution to the character or appearance of a conservation area.
