e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

Holly (T1) - fell because it is too close to the building, any further growth will cause building structure issue. Currently the tree is also block the boiler exhaustion pipe. Both the gardener and boiler service company recommended this. Won't replant anything where the tree currently are. But the proposed plans has other planting in other parts of garden

Fig (T2) - fell because it is pushing on to the fence. Recently purchased the flat, the seller told us she planted 3 fig trees she brought back from Greece in the same spot, didn't expect it to grow this big, you can see in the picture it is all growing together. Will replant with a VVA-1 Plum Tree, but away from the fence.
