#### Proposal:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Norway Maple (Acer platanoides) (T1) - Reduce crown all round by up to 1.5m, pruning to suitable growth points/branch fork junctions.

1 x Magnolia (T2) - Reduce and shape crown by around 2.5m height and 1.5m spread.

1 x Cherry (Prunus avium) (T3) - Fell to ground level leaving stump in ground.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 12 February 2021 and decided to **OBJECT** to the following work:

1 x Cherry (Prunus avium) (T3) - Fell to ground level leaving stump in ground.

### Reasons for objection:

The cherry tree is in the front/side garden of a residential property that is situated within the Hampstead Conservation Area. The tree is highly visible from the public realm and contributes to the green, leafy character and appearance of the conservation area.

The cherry tree is visible from the public realm in Cannon Place and Christchurch Hill. The prominence of the tree is heighten due to its position in

the property which is a corner plot. The crown of the cherry tree is asymmetric, however this is not considered a defect. The application form completed by the agent states that the owner is concerned about the safety of the cherry tree. No evidence has been submitted to demonstrate that the tree is in a hazardous condition. Removing the cherry tree would be harmful to the character and appearance of the conservation area.

A tree preservation order has been served on the cherry tree to protect the amenity the tree provides and the character and appearance of the conservation area.

# A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.

However, the Council would not have any objection to the carrying out of the following works:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Norway Maple (Acer platanoides) (T1) - Reduce crown all round by up to 1.5m, pruning to suitable growth points/branch fork junctions.

1 x Magnolia (T2) - Reduce and shape crown by around 2.5m height and 1.5m spread.
