Lime trees are particularly characteristic of our area and the loss of these two specimens would have a significant and hugely deleterious effect on the local streetscape and this conservation area in general, where far too many mature trees have been allowed to be felled. Camden has already permitted the felling of 24 mature trees in the South Hampstead Conservation Area within the last six months - among them five mature Lime trees. We understand that this application is yet another being demanded by an insurance company defending a claim against root damage to a neighbouring property - in this particular case, seemingly slight movement to the front steps. Camden has encouraged pollarding and other tree works in such circumstances many times in the past and it should surely be possible for arboriculturalists to carry out the necessary tree works which would prevent further property damage and make the felling of these majestic specimens unnecessary. We respectfully ask that the application be refused.
