I attach updated elevation drawings. These contain the railings as these are in place so the drawings show the building accurately.

I also attach the proposed window drawing again for reference. This is the product to be used.

I can confirm that the glazing bar is integrated. It is not a stick-on.

Please note that the website does not show the window as this is to be bespoke but you can see that they make traditional sash windows and inwardly tilting ones. What they will produce for this project is a traditional looking window of exactly the same proportions as current, including integrated glazing bar and horns. But one that tilts as the drawing.

I suggest that you talk to Howard directly to check any details you might still need. Also, am very happy to go ahead on the condition that you inspect and approve the actual windows when they are made. This way you can see for yourself that they are like for like in proportions before installation. Ok?
