				I first asked the councils planning department in February, how a second storey extension at the side of the house was being ¿enlarged¿ (as it is now described), in a conservation area, without planning permission. I¿ve received no answer but note that the work to do this is now complete and the scaffolding removed. The ¿enlargement¿ would appear to cover the entire footprint of the extension below. Is it retrospective planning permission that¿s being sort and if so can the full plans be posted to be commented on?
				The subject of second storey extensions in the Elsworthy Conservation area is problematic. For many years the council have had a policy of not allowing them, as it obscures the view of green space beyond from street level. There are infills to second floor (and even one 3 storey) in the street but these were completed in the 1930s, way before the creation of the conservation area. All applications of this sort since this time have been rejected and this one has been built without permission being sort, unless there has been a change of policy from L.B. Camden that has not been publicised. I would also observe that the yellow notice on the lamppost outside 143, posted during lockdown, so few people were likely to see it, states ¿comments till 5th April¿ but it states on this page, till the 10th of April.
