On behalf of The Belsize Society: this is a tall, mature tree visible from nearby streets and part of a narrow belt of trees between Glenilla Rd and Belsize Pk Gdns. This narrow woodland belt has already been depleted by developments to properties close by. Removing this mature tree would adversely affect the visual character of the locality, as well as damaging the ecosystem and wildlife habitat created by the belt of trees. It appears that the tree has not been pruned/repollarded since 2010 and a programme of pruning may prevent any future damage to buildings.
