Why is it necessary to o	demolish or extend (as	s applicable) all or part of the building(s) and or structure	e(s)?
The mansard roof sits atop the trapezoidal plan shape of the side annexe. The roof is not original. The listing states that the building was partially rebuilt, and the mansard was added, but it is unclear when this work was carried out. The plan shape of the mansard results in a cumbersome shape, and a clumsy space internally. Raising the parapet walls and adding a flat roof, will complete the elevation to the street and create an improved volume to the room inside. There is no similar feature along the length of the imposing and elegant Gloucester terrace west elevation. The side annexe with its low mansard creates a weak book end to the terrace. The proposed raised brick parapet, with a continuous stucco cornice detail and matching boxed sash windows will greatly improve the front elevation.
