Although seeming obviously sensible and unavoidable, the resulting disturbance to the front elevation is for the benefit of one flat somewhat at the expense of the other spacially. While that is up to the two owners, it seems to detract unnecessarily from the visible logic of a shared hall behind the one original door and the natural balance of the existing elevation. If two doors are to be so juxtaposed, it might better be served by a modified version of the existing oversize and squeezed door hood to cover both entrances. The change from original or similar entrance door to a pair of modern glazed doors cannot be welcome with the original features of the door surrounds. We consider the existing rear dormers should be retained rather than being combine dto dominate the roof slope.
