e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

T1: Robinia on Corner of Haversham Place entrance and Merton Lane: The stem has significant decay and consequently any regrowth in the upper crown is compromised. Although this tree is in decline it can be retained and managed. Proposed work: remove regrowth in upper crown; reduce the stem by 2 metres to provide a more structurally sound form.

T2: Large Cedar near entrance: remove disproportionate vertical branch on Eastern edge of upper crown.
