Dear Sir/Madam

I would like to object to the application to cut down (now amended to prune) the pear tree at 111 Broadhurst Gardens.

The garden (and therefore pear tree) is owned by 111 Broadhurst Gardens (Hampstead) Limited, the freehold owner of 111 Broadhurst Gardens. As noted by the applicant, he does not own the tree. He is not a shareholder of the company and therefore has no right to cut down the tree. The applicant has also not notified, or requested authorisation, from the freehold owner to submit his application.

I also strongly object to the amended application to prune the tree. This is on the basis that the applicant does not appear to have sought any professional opinion on the matter. I am extremely concerned that if permission is granted, the applicant will undertake works to the tree himself, which will likely cause extensive damage to the tree. I disagree that the tree causes any danger to garden users, as stated by the applicant.
