Although the application shows that the space between the chairs and the rental bikes docking station is 2 metres, when a bike is being taken from it's docking, this will reduce the space to nothing. This is a part of Holborn which has a very high footfall even at this time and these bikes are being hired all the times of day and night. The pavement is nowhere wide enough for pedestrians to be able to walk along if the licence is granted. We have had noise problems with Bounce in the past and this will only make matters worse. Also, a number of the residents of Gamages estate have brought to the attention of Bounce previously that the entranceways to the estate are used as public lavatories once Bounce has closed it's doors. We are very concerned that this will happen again with this application. The residents of Gamages estate already have the hassle of walking past patrons of Bounce queuing outside the premises and if the application is granted will have the extra inconvenience of having to walk past tables and chairs, waiters/waitresses and security.</p>
