I hope you're well.

Thank you for the Mansfield CAAC's objection to the above application, which was received in September 2020:

'The rear proposed new extension is in line with other acceptable examples but the first floor terrace may raise problems of overlooking consequent and loss of privacy.'

The proposal has subsequently been revised to remove the proposed balcony and to reinstate an external staircase between the first floor and the rear communal garden. Officers are of the opinion that the size of the landing would not encourage people to linger at this level, and that the proposed staircase would only result in incidental opportunities for overlooking towards the adjacent neighbour No. 54. Furthermore, the proposal would improve upon the existing situation, as the depth of the existing first floor balcony facilitates use of this area as amenity space and enables overlooking towards No. 54. No comments or objections have been received from the occupiers of No. 54.

Please can I ask you to review the revised drawings and confirm by reply whether the MCAAC would like to withdraw their objection. This would enable the application to be dealt with under delegated powers, rather than being referred to the Members Briefing Panel first.
