I have reviewed the revised submission and note that a revised Construction Method Statement (CMS) has not been provided (we have rev 01, dated 25 June 2019). In the BIA audit we queried the ground movement monitoring trigger values presented in the CMS, as they did not reflect the assessment undertaken in the BIA.

Now that the BIA and ground movement assessment has been revised and updated, could you please provide confirmation that the monitoring trigger values will be updated to reflect the values calculated in the BIA?

We would accept e-mail confirmation as opposed to a full revision of the CMS, unless the version of the CMS that we have has been subsequently superseded.
