The proposed streetpole and cabinets, by reason of their size, design and location, would be an incongruous form of development that would create additional visual clutter in the streetscene and cause harm to the character and appearance of the Regents Park Conservation Area and the area generally, as well as to the setting of nearby historic and listed buildings, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
