This application refers to a number of trees needing attention in Elm Village, but unfortunately, the greatly overgrown forest trees in **Rossendale Way, NW1 0XB** have been missed off the list for the proposed works. Residents in Rossendale Way are growing increasingly concerned as, if/when one or more of these trees comes down, it will cause enormous damage to properties, possibly even to the point of complete destruction.

As you will know from your records, a large elm tree in Elm Village came down last year, and another tree at the entrance to the estate has come down today, and we feel that the matter is increasingly pressing.

Residents in Rossendale Way now post an urgent request that the trees in this part of Elm Village are assessed immediately before any possibly irreparable damage occurs.
