Further to your query regarding noise from the substations in the attached email, we have consulted with the mechanical and electrical engineer and they have provided the confirmation below and in the attached emails that the two systems (ring main unit and switch room) will not generate noise.

I also note that the principle of introducing substations is established under permitted development rights (under Schedule 2, Part 5, Class B of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015) with a requirement to agree external treatment but without consideration of noise.

Can you confirm whether this gives you sufficient reassurance on noise to determine this application?
