I am writing on behalf, of the Seven Dials CAAC regarding [2021/0792/P](#) & 2021/1577/L.

Our assessment of the proposed changes are that, the existing and proposed front and rear elevations suggest there aren't going to be any changes to the layout.

The photomontages show obvious changes to the signage, but the colour scheme appears to be remaining pretty much as it already is (as the Belgo restaurant).

The photomontages do seem to include new decorative lighting outside as part of the signage, which we have slight reservations about.

Additionally, we have some concerns regarding the opening hours as the property has lots of residential neighbours.
