No objection in principle to the addition of an infill rear extension at lower ground floor level, but strong objection to

the design of the rear elevation.

It is a feature of the terraces in Primrose Hill that the back addition projects to the rear across only part of the plot width, creating a rhythm of solid and void. By treating the void as distinct from the solid, it is possible to create a garden level infill which respects this distinction. The current proposal, however, crudely breaks this rhythm by treating the infilled void and solid as if they were the same. This is harmful to the character and appearance of the conservation area, which it neither preserves not enhances.

We also note that the roof to the proposed extension is glazed: what steps will be taken effectively to mitigate the problems of light pollution damaging the amenity of

neighbours?
