It would be approximately twice the height of any building in the vicinity, dwarfing housing blocks and dominating the skyline. In addition the proposed street cabinets will impede circulation of pedestrians and motorists causing a safety hazard.</p>

It will significantly spoil the appearance of our conservation area by being a visual eyesore and a blot on and above the horizon and that this telecoms tower will inevitably be clearly visible from the balconies at Kingswood Court, 48 West End Lane NW6 where I live. It will also be visible from Abbey Road and West End Lane, both of which lie in the main conservation area.</p> <p>Also that this installation on the narrow pavement outside Bishopsdale House (a classic 1950s style block of flats) will be in very close proximity to the residents who live in this building. On the opposite side of the narrow stretch of West End Lane are 9 classic Edwardian residential dwellings which will also be in close proximity to the telecoms tower. The height, size and location would form an over dominant feature in the street scene and immediate area contributing to visual clutter.</p> <p>I am also extremely concerned about the inevitable health risks of the radio frequency radiation transmitted from the tower as there has not been any health risk assessment to prove that the technology in the format is safe and therefore this application should be refused.</p>
