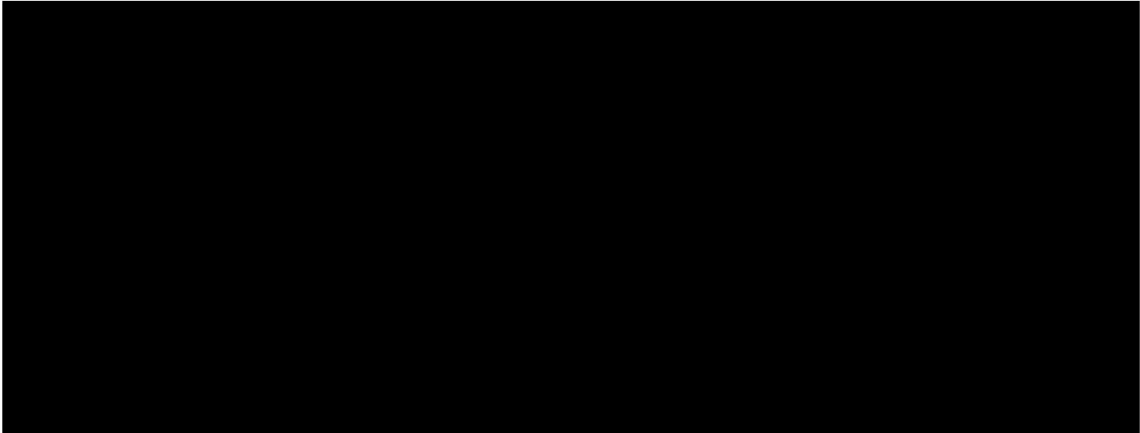

The Proposed Work:

RECONSULTATION WITH UPDATED DESCRIPTION, RED LINE AND ADDENDUM: Request for scoping opinion under Regulation 15 of the Town and Country Planning Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations 2017, for proposed development comprising 17 development plots with circa 750-825 homes (including a proportion of affordable housing), circa 95,500sqm of commercial floorspace including up to approximately: 40,760sqm industry (Classes B2, B8 and E(g)(i)); 34,000sqm flexible office and research and development (Classes E(g)(i) and (ii)); 36,000sqm research and development (Class E(g)(ii)); 3,500sqm of retail/leisure (Classes E(a), (b), (d) and Sui Generis); 8,000sqm residential institution (Class C2) and 1,300sqm community uses (Class F1/F2).

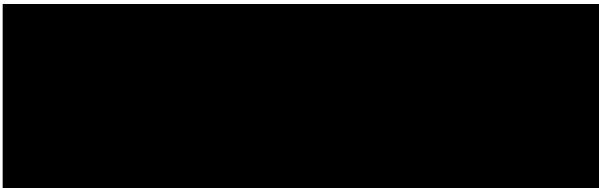

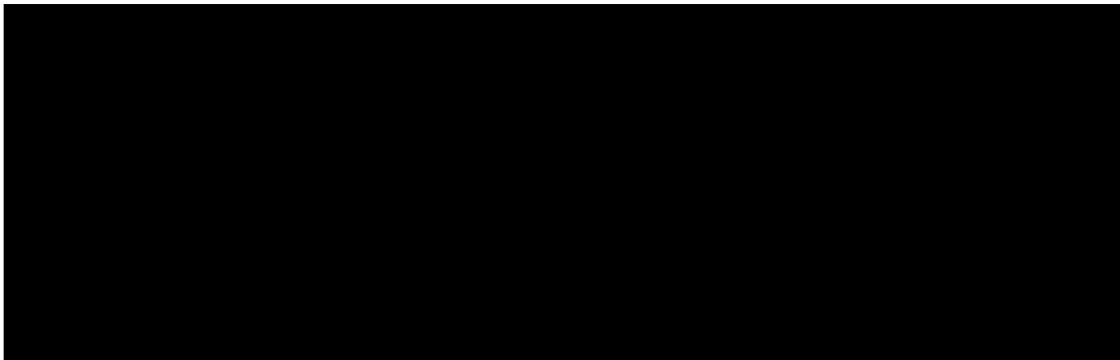
