Assessment
At the time of the section 211 notification the ash tree was showing signs of ash dieback (Chalara fraxinea). A tree preservation order was served to protect the tree as it is visible from the public realm, makes a positive contribution to the character and appearance of the conservation area as well as to give the Council time to assess the degree to which the disease is impacting on the tree to see whether it would succumb. Unfortunately weeping ash trees seem to be particularly rapidly affected by ash dieback and it is clear that the health of this individual has further deteriorated. In view of the poor condition of the tree it is considered that it would be now be appropriate to approve the removal of this tree subject to a replacement tree required by condition.
