T2 Unclear exactly why this tree should be felled as it is not identified in the photos3. T3 and T4 seem to be in poor condition but they appear to have been neglected and the decking at the rear of the garden seems to be rather to close. The applicant should consider planting more suitable replacement trees.4. The Cherry Tree is included in Landscaping Condition in 20123/0451/P. Again, it is unclear from the photo whether it is dead or is late flowering because of our exceptional weather this spring. It, too, seems sadly neglected and surrounded by decking. A replacement tree should be planted5. T6 and T7 No Objection <p>This seems a lot of trees to fell with no suggestion of replacement planting.
